JOB DESCRIPTION

POSITION TITLE: GROUNDS

DEFINITION: Under supervision of the Maintenance and Operations Foreman performs maintenance tasks in the care of landscaped areas.

ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS: *Duties may include, but are not limited to the following:*

- Cultivate, water and trim lawns.
- Operate a power mower, power edger, tractor and other power equipment.
- Assist in the preparation and lining of athletic fields.
- Remove paper and other debris from turf and landscaped areas.
- Drive district vehicle.
- Assist in the preparation of turf and lawn areas, general grounds, maintenance work, and in moving equipment and furniture when necessary.
- Assist in the planting and trimming of trees, flowers and shrubs.
- Use hand tools.
- Recommend control of plant pests and diseases.
- Maintain fertilizing schedules of trees, shrubs and lawns.
- Clean up related to job assignment.
- Other duties as assigned.

QUALIFICATIONS:

Knowledge of:

- Basic methods, supplies and tools used in cultivating and caring for grounds.

Ability to:

- Operate power equipment related to landscaping and gardening.
- Operate automatic sprinkling system clocks.
- Learn the procedures and use of tools in gardening work.
- Carry out oral and written instructions.
- Develop and maintain cooperative working relations with those contacted in the course of work.
- Cooperate with faculty and other staff.
- Perform general gardening and grounds work.
- Perform heavy physical labor.

EDUCATION AND EXPERIENCE:

- Any combination of experience and education that would provide the required knowledge and abilities listed herein.
- One year in grounds work.
- Completion of the twelfth grade.

POSITION TITLE: GROUNDS, <i>Continued</i>
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PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS: *of this position are, but not limited to the following:*

Ability to:

- Sit for extended periods of time.
- Stand in one area for extended periods of time.
- Stand and walk for extended periods of time.
- Ascend and descend steps.
- See for purposes of reading work orders, diagrams, labels and other printed material.
- Hear and understand speech at normal levels.
- Communicate so others will clearly understand normal conversation.
- Communicate using the telephone and radio.
- Operate hand tools, mechanical equipment and power tools with dexterity.
- Operate district vehicles.
- Push/pull, squat, turn, twist, bend, and stoop.
- Reach in all directions.
- Lift/carry up to 40 lbs. and to occasionally lift/carry equipment and supplies weighing up to 80 lbs.
- Think clearly and rationally to solve problems, make good judgments and decisions.
- Perform the essential functions of this position in an accurate and timely fashion.
- Ability to meet the travel requirements of this position.

WORKING CONDITIONS:

Indoor and outdoor working environments subject to bending, crouching, and kneeling in confined spaces such as attics and sub-floor areas; pushing/pulling of equipment and tools; reaching in all directions; long periods of standing/walking, and with appropriate safety equipment, working with potentially hazardous materials/equipment, solvents, paints, grease, oil, and other chemicals.

LICENSE OR CERTIFICATE:

- Possession of a valid California Driver's license.
- Clearance for use of chemicals in spraying pesticides.
- Valid CPR/First Aid Certification is desirable.
